Robert F. Julian affirms under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. I am the attorney for Justice Erin Gall.
2. I spoke with Administrator and Counsel Robert Tembeckjian on Thursday,


December 12, 2024, requesting that the Commission stipulate that pursuant to Section 530.10 of the Rules for Review of Determinations of the State of Commission on Judicial Conduct to the withdrawal of Justice Gall's request for review and advising him of Justice Gall's intent to resign.

3. Mr. Tembeckjian advised me that he had been instructed by the Commission not to so stipulate.

WHEREFORE on behalf of Justice Gall we move to the Court requesting:

- a) That the Court grant withdrawal of the review or in the alternative, grant  
Petitioner's request to submit without oral argument.
- b) Permit argument by submission.

AFFIDAVIT OF  
ERIN P. GALL

Erin P. Gall, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. On July 17, 2024, I was served with the decision of the Judicial Commission recommending removal.
2. On July 22, 2024, I received a notice of suspension.
3. On August 16, 2024, I submitted a request to the Court of Appeals for review of the Commission's decision to preserve my rights.
4. On August 19, 2024, the Court of Appeals issued a decision/order setting forth a briefing schedule. My attorney submitted a brief outlining what I believe to be meritorious

arguments. We received Commission counsel's response and submitted our final reply on October 22, 2024.

5. Throughout the months of September, October, and November, I updated my resume, reviewed job opportunities, applied to over 30 jobs and went on several interviews. I have been a Supreme Court Justice for 13 years and have cherished every moment in that role. The decision to no longer pursue review and abandon hope of remaining on the bench has been extremely difficult. I have experienced a range of emotions over the last 3 ½ months, wavering between fighting for my job and what is in the best interests of my family.

6. Immediately after the issuance of the Commission's decision, my story was carried by not only local but national news and social media. The attention incited numerous physical threats upon my family, requiring 24-hour law enforcement protection. In particular, my two sons received numerous death threats. The fear has been immeasurable and terrifying. I do not believe that I can move forward with arguing this appeal for fear that my family will be put in danger once again. I have two children in college and their colleges have been made public, putting them in serious harm. The decision to abandon my appeal has been one of the most difficult decisions I've had to make but I must put the safety of my family first.


7. I am enclosing my letter dated December 15, 2024, resigning as a Justice of the New York State Supreme Court.

8. There is no prejudice to the Commission should you grant my request for withdrawal because I am no longer opposing the Commission's recommendation for removal. I also agree to never seek judicial office in the future. I have resigned from my position and have no intention to remain on the bench even if I were to succeed before the Court of Appeals.

9. If the Court grants my motion to withdraw and upholds the recommendation of the Commission, I would ask that there be no specific findings other than removal to help lessen any potential harm to my family due to social media and national news exposure. I certainly do not think it fair to characterize my reactions as racially motivated and to stigmatize me with that finding based on the facts in the case.

10. In the alternative, if the Court denies my motion to withdraw, I ask that the Court take this matter on submission. Arguments by both sides have been set forth exhaustively in the pleadings. Oral argument will not serve any additional purpose other than additional trauma to myself and my family.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner is respectfully requesting an Order to Withdraw the Request for Review in this matter or in the alternative, granting Petitioner's request to submit without oral argument and for such other relief as to the Court may seem just and proper.


Dear Justice Zayas:
